Pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717f(c), and Part 157 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, Equitrans, L.P. submits the attached application requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity and required authorizations for the Ohio Valley Connector Expansion Project. The Ohio Valley Connector Expansion Project consists of: the acquisition of the existing non-jurisdictional Cygrymus Compressor Station in Greene County, Pennsylvania and the construction of (i) two turbines at the Cygrymus Compressor Station; (ii) one additional compressor unit at the existing Corona Compressor Station Wetzel County, West Virginia; (iii) one additional compressor unit at the existing Plasma Compressor Station in Monroe County, Ohio; (iv) approximately 5.5 miles of pipeline in different locations related to the compressor stations; (v) one deep anode groundbed and rectifier for cathodic protection in Greene County, PA; and (vi) ancillary facilities.
